

EYES



Asian—Referred to as a single or vanishing eyelid, appearing as a flat surface when closed due to lack of natural crease



Close-Set—Eyes that are less than one eye width apart



Deep-Set—Set deep, making browbone appear more noticeable



Hooded—Set so the natural crease in the eyelid is not seen

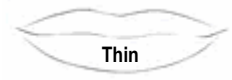


Standard—Set about one eye width apart



Wide-Set—Eyes that are more than one eye width apart

LIPS



Thin

FACE



Round—Features shorter, wide, full cheeks and a rounded chin.



Square—Strong and balanced, with equal width at the forehead, cheek and chin.



Oval—Symmetrical



Heart—Forehead is wider than chin, and chin tapers to relatively narrow or pointed
